**RE: Notice of Clarification for Cases Governed by the DeKalb County School Calendar,
Domestic Relations Custody Orders for School and Holiday Visitation**

Questions have arisen with respect to the interpretation of child visitation schedules during the school closings necessitated by the Coronavirus / COVID -19. In an effort to help the Family Law Bar to advise your clients, the DeKalb Superior Court Judges have met and unanimously agreed that in all cases in which child visitation periods are governed by the DeKalb County school calendar, visitation will continue to be governed by the previously published school calendar regardless of any break or homeschooling necessitated by the current public health crisis. Spring Break, holiday and summer visitation periods will continue to be governed by the controlling school calendar in the manner stated in the applicable custody order in each case.
